MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY Estimated Resident Undergraduate and Graduate Budget

The sample budgets below represent average costs for 2017-2018 academic year. These budgets are based on 15 credits/semester for undergraduate students and 9 credits/semester for graduate students. An academic year is fall/spring.

Students are assessed tuition each semester on the basis of their level, class, residency status, number of credits carried and beginning year of enrollment. Tuition is assessed on a per credit-hour basis except for graduate-professional students who are assessed on a semester basis and selected Masters program students who are assessed on a semester, annual or program basis.

Room and board costs in the budget include a double room, linen service, Silver meal plan and use of study, laundry and recreational facilities. Actual room and board costs for students living off campus may vary from the figures below.
